Capital Campaign Frequently Asked Questions

1. How long will the roofing project take once it gets started?

Hance Construction has indicated that once the materials arrive the project can begin. Hance estimates that the roof will be replaced with in 12-16 weeks.

2. When will I receive pledge payment reminders?

The Parish Office is currently itemizing past payments and will be sending out monthly statements in March. Those statements will have a remit slip to include with your payment. Please be patient as we work through this process.

3. How can I support the capital campaign?

We are asking every parish family to support the campaign. This can be done through an outright gift, pledge commitment, or planned gift. If families have already pledged, they can extend their pledge commitment. If you have fulfilled your pledge, please consider making another gift or pledge to the campaign.

4. What other projects will be funded through the Capital Campaign?

If the parish surpasses the \$600,000 goal, additional projects can be addressed, including repairs to the church roof, upgrades to the church HVAC system, and improvements to the parking lot.
