EMERGENCY SAFETY PLANS

In order to address this we are pleased to welcome Dennis Reilly from the County Prosecutor's Office and Police Chief Tom Cicerelle of Washington Township to speak to all parishioners about an Emergency Preparedness Plan.

They are coming to speak to us <u>after the 5:00 PM Mass on Saturday</u>, February 15 and after the 11:00AM Mass on <u>Sunday</u>, February 16. All you have to do is stick around after Mass. We urge all parishioners to stay after Mass on one of those days or plan to be here after one of those Masses in order to hear this important presentation. The presentation will last approximately 30 minutes.

SCRIP/GIFT CARDS

At the January 16 meeting of the Parish Council it was decided to discontinue the SCRIP/Gift card Program until further notice. This is because of an extremely low level of participation in the program.

Very few of our parishioners have been participating to the point that we aren't making any significant money for the parish and are actually close to merely breaking even. Since this is supposed to be a parish fundraiser that sort of defeats the purpose.

In addition, it has become increasingly difficult to get a sufficient number of parishioners to volunteer to take orders and sell the gift cards after Masses on the weekends.

As a result, the Parish Council advised, and I have concurred, that the program will be discontinued for the present. Perhaps, at some point in the future, we can reinstate the program. The discontinuation is effective as of February 9, 2020.
