Pandemic Restrictions and social distancing are certainly going to remain in place throughout the rest of April and probably well into May. The NJ Schools aren't set to re-open (at least for now) until May 15. It is our sincere hope that by the middle of May we will be able to resume normal parish activity. But, we will keep you posted.

BISHOPS ANNUAL APPEAL

As of the writing of this bulletin our parish has so far pledged \$18,118.00 and has so far paid \$16,078.00 toward our parish goal of \$27,000.00. These pledges have been received from 92 households.

We just have a little over \$8,000.00 to go!

FROM THE PASTOR

We are continuing to celebrate the immense truth that Christ came back from the dead and conquered the power of sin and death. Through this He has made real forgiveness of our

sins a possibility and granted to us the opportunity to have eternal life. This is true, whether we are together in church to hear about it or not.

Thank You to those of you who have made pledges to the Bishop's Annual Appeal. As of today we have pledges totaling \$18,118.00. That's great! We only have \$8,882.00 to go. The amount that has already been pledged is from just 92 households, however. That represents fewer than half the number of people who made pledges last year.

That means that if every other family in the parish who has not yet done so would simply pledge \$100.00 to the Bishop's Annual Appeal we would reach, and actually slightly surpass, our Parish Goal. We're almost there. Please, if you have not already made a pledge, consider doing so. Remember that we get 50% back on all money that goes over the goal we might raise.

I would be remiss if I didn't also add a word of **THANKS** for your kindness and generosity in remembering to send in (or to give online) your weekly parish offering. This is helping us tremendously to pay the bills and keep things running so that when this Pandemic is over you all still have a church to come back to!

If you haven't yet looked at the parish Facebook page I urge you to do so. In addition to <u>live streaming Mass every Sunday at 11:00AM</u> I also periodically check in with an online live chat. They're not long but I spend a few moments with some *"Coffee & Conversation"* to offer a word for thought, some encouragement, some news and a moment of prayer. After they are done live they continue to be available to be viewed at any time.

Please try to keep a positive attitude during these trying times. You know, prayer helps a lot with that! Open your heart to God and share with Him all you are going through. He is <u>ALWAYS</u> listening and happy to hear from you. Even if it is your fear, frustration or anger...He will take it all. You can say anything to God. So, don't hesitate to do so.
