Blessed Francis Xavier Seelos was born in 1819, in Bavaria. He attended university in Munich, where he heard about the Redemptorists who he joined asking to be sent as a missionary to the US. In 1843, he arrived in New York, and was ordained in Baltimore, Maryland, in 1844. For six years, Seelos worked in Pittsburgh, in the Midwest and the Mid-Atlantic ending up in New Orleans. There, he worked diligently to care for people with yellow fever, until 1867 when, having caught the disease himself, Seelos died at the age of 48. He was Beatified by Pope John Paul II in 2000.
