2021 BISHOP'S ANNUAL APPEAL

"Transformed by Christ Body and Blood Sent on Mission to Light a Fire in the Heart of the Church"

As of this week our parish has had \$32,960.25 pledged by 139 households and has already paid \$29,906.50 towards our parish goal.

That's 117.72% of our goal!

We have received our first rebate from the Diocese for \$2,203.25. That represents half the amount over goal we raised as of June 24. We will receive another rebate in November for anything received after July 1.

THANK YOU to all of you for your generosity and for surpassing this goal. As a parish family we did more than our part toward the wider \$7.2 million diocesan goal.

DAILY MASS FOR THE SUMMER

Please take note of a temporary change that affects the celebration of daily Mass in our parish. Until the end of August the daily Mass celebrated at 9:00AM Monday - Friday will be celebrated in the Cry Room and not in the main body of the church.

In past years we used to get as many as 25 or even 30 people at daily Mass. This has been slowly dwindling over the years as some daily Mass attendees have become unable to be in church, have moved away or, sadly, have died. The number of daily Mass attendees is now somewhere around 15. In addition. during the warmest summer months it is far easier and more efficient to air condition the smaller Cry Room rather than run the air conditioning for the whole church. This will be a better use of our system so it will be more energy efficient and fiscally responsible.



BINGO IS BACK!
