ASCENSION OF THE LORD

His Eminence, Joseph Cardinal Tobin, Metropolitan Archbishop of Newark, asked all the bishops in the Ecclesiastical Province of Newark (i.e. the state of New Jersey) to vote on whether or not to transfer the observance of the Ascension from Thursday to the following Sunday. Most of the dioceses in the United States have transferred this observance to the following Sunday. Only the Provinces of Boston, New York, Hartford, Newark, Philadelphia and Omaha continue to observe the Ascension on a Thursday.

The bishops of New Jersey voted to move the observance of the feast for this year. So, the **Solemnity of the Lord's Ascension is transferred** from Thursday, May 13 to **Sunday May 16** in all the dioceses of New Jersey.

This change is to take effect for *this year only*. At present the bishops decided to make this change but it will be revisited and evaluated at their next regular meeting. This may become a permanent change but for now that remains an open question.
