FROM THE PASTOR



I hope that you are all having a good and spiritually fruitful Lent.

Please take note that the Sacrament of Penance is available on Saturdays (4:00-4:45pm), Wednesdays (7:15-8:00pm),

and Fridays in Lent (7:00-8:00pm). n Fridays the Blessed Sacrament is also exposed in church for adoration.

Every Friday in Lent right after the 9:00 morning Mass Stations of the Cross are prayed communally in church.

This year the Special Lenten Penance Service will take place on Wednesday, April 6 from 7:00-8:00pm. The Blessed Sacrament will be exposed for adoration and during that time five priests will be available to hear your Confessions (including one who speaks Spanish). I hope that as many of you as can will come to make a good Confession before Holy Week.

These will be the last scheduled Confessions prior to Easter. Regular Confessions will not resume in the parish until after the Easter Octave on Saturday, April 30.

Something else to take note of is that this coming Friday, March 25 is the Solemnity of the Annunciation of the Lord. It's not a holy day of obligation. But, it is significant this year because it is a major solemnity and it happens to fall on a Friday in Lent. So what? Well, on solemnities in the Church calendar it is not appropriate to do acts of penance. So this year on March 25 even though it is a Friday you do not have to abstain from eating meat. In celebration of the Lord's Annunciation you are dispensed from the obligation to abstain.

Of course, if you wish to abstain from meat that day you are free to do so. In addition, if you choose you can abstain from eating meat on another day this coming week in order to "make up for" Friday. That is entirely up to you.

I hope you have a blessed week ahead. Remember, always, to Keep The Faith!
