

The Knights of Columbus Council 5170 will be sponsoring a blood drive on Sunday, June 19 in the Parish Center 8:00am -2:00pm.



# **FROM THE PASTOR**



Christ is Risen! Alleluia!

Say a prayer for our nine 2nd Graders who received their First Holy Communion on Saturday morning, May 21. May God fill them with His grace and love.

Last Saturday, May 14, our bishop ordained 15 new Permanent Deacons for our diocese. This class was the first ever to be made up of primarily Spanish-speaking men. I am happy to say that one of these new Deacons has been assigned to assist at our parish!

Beginning next week **Deacon Paul Flor**, who has been a parishioner at our neighboring parish, St. Philip & St. James in Phillipsburg, for many years will become the third Deacon serving here at St. Joseph. He will be serving here three weekends each month and will also assist one weekend per month at Assumption Church in Hackettstown.

This is a great blessing to our parish. Combined with the regular monthly help we are also receiving from Fr. Yohan Serrano with our Spanish Masses and Confessions we are better able to serve our Spanish-speaking brothers and sisters. Remember that I always say: *this is ONE parish with TWO languages*.

Deacon Paul speaks Spanish as his first language but is also fluent in English as well. So, his ministry will not be limited to the Hispanic Community. He will also take a full part in the all the pastoral ministries of the parish and assist whenever possible in the full liturgical and sacramental life of our parish.

This is, as I say, a great blessing to our parish. Our two other Deacons, Edmund Hartmann and Sylvan Webb, have been serving this parish for many years and they both do a lot to assist me in the pastoral care of our parishioners. The addition of a third Deacon will benefit us all. But, this will also be a great help to me personally. My fluency in Spanish is not great and I feel the Hispanic parishioners here have not been served as well as I would have liked in the years since we no longer have had a second priest here to help with that. We've been "getting by" but that's not really good enough. Now, with the monthly help of Fr. Serrano and the regular assistance of Deacon Paul our Latino parishioners will be much better served and the rest of our parishioners will also benefit from Deacon Paul's ministry.

God has been good to us...as He always is. May He fill the week ahead with many blessings and the peace of His presence for all of you, your families and all those you love.
