# **FROM THE PASTOR**

Just now, I'm working on getting some lumber to build a small firewood shed behind the garage. Most nights, during the past week or so, I have lighted a fire in the rectory fireplace. The wood behind the garage has been exposed to the weather for a number of years and some of it is partially rotted and damp. Nevertheless, I have been burning it each night so that nothing goes to waste.

As it is now, there is only enough wood left for about another week. I already have made arrangements to have some firewood delivered at no cost; a generous donation to our parish! As for the woodshed, I am working on obtaining some building material at no cost to the parish. It will be better to keep the wood dry since it will burn more efficiently and safely. Also, the wood stored behind the garage, visible from the parking lot (although at a distance) will present a much more aesthetical appearance.

A friend of mine who works part time as a musician called yesterday just to see how I am doing in my new assignment. He lives only about twenty minutes from Washington but attends Mass in another parish where he plays the organ on weekends. In the course of our conversation, he said that he has some free time during weekdays and would be willing to help out with anything we need at the parish. It was then that he mentioned that he is skilled in carpentry. I couldn't help thinking about the woodshed project that I would like to get going before the snow falls so I asked if he would be willing to work on it. He's glad to take this project into hand!

Hopefully, within the next month or so, if you drive into the parking lot behind the rectory, you might just spot the new woodshed, complete with fresh firewood, located behind the rectory garage.

I'm so thankful for those willing to donate firewood, building materials and labor towards this project. It will help provide a nice ambiance in the rectory as well as defer the heating bills during the winter months.
