
OUTREACH MINISTRY.....LOOKING AHEAD

FROM THE PASTOR

Dear Parishioners of Saint Joseph,

Recently, I announced that our parish would be starting Eucharistic Adoration. Our plan is to expose the Blessed Sacrament in the Montrance on our Altar for one hour each Friday following the 9:00am Daily Mass. Our start date for this will be Friday, September 29th, the Feast of the Archangels Michael, Gabriel and Raphael. Our hope is that parishioners will come out for that hour of Adoration and that we can extend the time of Adoration if more adorers would like to come out.

I can't tell you how many times parishioners in various parishes where I've served or helped out have reported how Adoration has transformed their relationship with God. Individuals and couples who were not really familiar with Adoration previously, found out about it in their parish, decided to give it a try and some time and dedication, and soon found out that they longed to return because of the benefits they experienced from Adoration of the Blessed Sacrament. This is what people say about their experience with Adoration: They experience a more profound peace in their lives; a deepening in their assurance of God's abiding presence, sustenance, providence and loving care; a more accurate sense of self, the meaning of life and their own purpose before God and within His community; a greater willingness to accept all things, circumstances and occurrences as coming from or permitted by God so as to more easily bear the burdens of life (our crosses) in union of Christ as well as to more fully share our joys with Him and to experience the overflow of His joy into our lives and so, in these and many other ways to feel more fulfilled in life, despite its daily challenges.

As a seminarian student, I recall it being said that studies have actually shown that, in

parishes and dioceses where Eucharistic Adoration is prevalent, there is an increase of vocations to the priesthood and religious life. Our prayers for vocations are evidently greatly increased through a devotion to adoration of Jesus in the Most Blessed Sacrament.

Please consider, if your work schedule and other commitments in the fulfillment of your daily duty permits, to come out to our church and spend some time before our Lord Jesus, truly and really present in the Most Blessed Sacrament.
