BISHOP'S APPEAL

Our Bishop's Annual Appeal Goal this year is once again \$28,000.00. So far, this year, as of August 25, our parish has pledged \$18,117.60 which represents 64.71% of our goal.

CAPITAL CAMPAIGN UPDATE

According to information received this past week from Giving Trend, the company administering our Capital Campaign the total amount pledged to the campaign as of August 22 is: \$450,990.71. The total amount that has been paid is: \$363,399.71.

Our goal is to reach \$600,000. So far expenses (including Giving Trend fees, last year's Bishop's Appeal goal and replacement of the Parish Center HVAC units) amounted to \$123,398.00. That means our adjusted cash-on-hand is: \$240,001.71.

FROM THE PASTOR

Dear Parishioners of Saint Joseph,

During this past Lenten season, I received a phone call one weekday morning from the Director of Priest Personnel here in the Diocese of Metuchen. When I answered the call, it was in the privacy of my room in the rectory. During the course of our conversation, among other things, we discussed my transfer to Saint Joseph Church in Washington and some of the particular needs of the parishioners here.

After hanging up the phone, I immediately went into my office, closed the door, and went online until I found what I was looking for. \$115.00 later, my order was placed and three days after that my package arrived. Immediately, upon opening the package, I began to read from its contents, that is, from the Misal Romano, the Spanish edition of the Roman Missal which priests use at the altar for the celebration of the Mass.

Many years ago, as a freshman in High School, I had to drop the elective I had taken in Spanish because of what my Spanish professor had told me at the time. I never forgot the very words he used when he said to me: "You have a snowball's chance in hell of passing this course!" As of now, having taken lessons from a friend whose first language is Spanish, I have been already celebrating the Mass in Spanish (privately, since the month of May) in preparation for my assignment here at Saint Joseph's.

It was back in the month of May, after I had spoken with the personnel director and discussed this assignment with the bishop during his annual visitation of parishes, that the bishop asked me to come down to his office for a more formal meeting about this assignment. I left his office after that meeting knowing that I would be starting a new assignment in Washington on September 1st, but wasn't allowed to tell anyone yet. Then in June, Laura called me from Washington asking if I could take a funeral here at Saint Joseph's since Father Guy was away. I agreed to come for the

funeral, but wasn't sure if word had somehow leaked out. I was thinking that people in Washington might already know that I was to be their new pastor. When I arrived for the funeral, there were people here who were getting everything ready for the Mass. No one said a word about my coming here. It seemed that no one here knew about it yet. And then, when everything was set and we had a few minutes to wait for the arrival of the family of the deceased, we were just chatting when a lady, one of the parishioners here, who had helped set up for the Mass said to me: "We're getting a new pastor." I stood right next to her thinking "Yes, I know, I'm your new pastor", but, at that time, I couldn't say a word.

That experience gave me an opportunity to experience people here at Saint Joseph as their authentic selves and what I saw and heard filled me with great joy. I knew right then that I was going to be at the service of very good people, holy people even! Those people are all of you and I consider myself truly blessed to be called to your service as your new pastor. I look forward with great anticipation to working with you, being of service to you, and getting to know all of you here at my new home, Saint Joseph Church in Washington!
